

Approved Procedure

Required by the *Electoral Act 2004*, section 118(4)(c)

Approved by the Tasmanian Electoral Commission on 1 April 2005

For the purposes of section 118(4)(c) of the *Electoral Act 2004*, the Tasmanian Electoral Commission approve the following procedure:

The person is to—

- go to an unoccupied voting screen in the polling place;
- mark his or her vote on the ballot paper in accordance with the directions on that ballot paper;
- fold the ballot paper so as to conceal the vote;
- return it folded to the issuing officer for inclusion in the declaration envelope; and
- deposit the sealed envelope in a ballot box.
