## Who can lodge a postal vote?

If you are entitled to vote at a Tasmanian election, you may vote by postal vote if you:

- » expect to be unable to attend a polling place on polling day; **or**
- » are a silent elector whose address is not shown on the roll. *Section 36(5).*

## How do I apply for a postal vote?



Complete and sign this form.



Return this form, so it can be received by the returning officer **before 4pm Friday, eight days before polling day**. Remember, postal services can take a number of days.

## What happens next?

Mail your postal ballot pack to you

The pack is made up of: ballot paper/s, instructions, return envelopes

Complete your vote before 6pm on polling day
