Who can lodge a postal vote?

If you are entitled to vote at a Tasmanian election, you may vote by postal vote if you:

- » expect to be unable to attend a polling place on polling day; or
- are a silent elector whose address is not shown on the roll. Section 36(5).

How do I apply for a postal vote?

Return this form, so it can be received by the returning officer before 4pm Friday, eight days before polling day. Remember, postal services can take a number of days.





