Under section 128(1)(a) of the *Electoral Act 2004* ("the Act"), the Tasmanian Electoral Commission approved the following method for delivery of postal vote material to hospitals, convalescent homes, and nursing homes if the Commission does not appoint mobile polling places or appoint places at which mobile polling may be operated under section 92 of the Act for an election:

An election official is to place individual postal vote packs for residents or patients of a hospital, convalescent home, or nursing home within an express post parcel addressed to an appointed contact person at that place, who will deliver the postal vote packs to eligible electors.
