Nomination forms are available from the Tasmanian Electoral Commission.
Eligibility to contest the recount
Persons who were candidates at the 2 election in the Division of, who were not elected at that election, and who are still qualified under the <i>Constitution Act 1934</i> to be elected as a Member of the Assembly, may nominate to contest the recount.
At the recount, only the votes which elected the vacating member will be redistributed to candidates who nominate for the recount.
