



Electoral Act 2004 – sections 45 & 57(3)

Application for change of name of registered party

The Tasmanian Electoral Commission has received an application under section 57 for a change of name of or in respect of –

SHOOTERS AND FISHERS PARTY TASMANIA

The application relates to a proposed change in both the registered name of the party and the ballot paper name.

It is proposed to change the registered name to –

SHOOTERS, FISHERS AND FARMERS PARTY TASMANIA

It is proposed to change the ballot paper name to –

SHOOTERS, FISHERS, FARMERS TAS

In accordance with sections 57(3), 44 and 46 of the *Electoral Act 2004*, a person may lodge an objection against the application to change the name of the party with the Tasmanian Electoral Commission (TEC). The objection may only be on a ground specified in section 47 of the Act. Objections may be lodged online at the TEC website (www.tec.tas.gov.au) or sent by post or email at the addresses shown below. Objections must be received no later than 5pm on Monday 26 June 2017.
