

Candidates announced

When nominations closed at 12 noon on Thursday 14 April 2016, seven candidates (three men and four women) had been nominated to contest the 2016 Legislative Council elections to be held on Saturday 7 May 2016. Voting is compulsory.

By division candidate numbers are—

Division of Apsley	4 candidates
Division of Elwick	3 candidates

A list of candidates for each division can be found [on our website](#). Candidates are listed in alphabetical order. It should be remembered that the names on the ballot paper are rotated and may not appear in this order. If a candidate has been nominated by a registered party or has requested that the word “Independent” appear under their name, this will be indicated on the ballot paper.

Electors who cannot get to a polling place on polling day must vote early. They can vote early at the following pre-poll voting centres during normal weekday business hours:

Hobart:

Launceston:

(from Tues 26 April to Friday 6 May)

Glenorchy:

(from Mon 2 May to Friday 6 May)

Scottsdale:

St Barnabas' Church Hall, 55 King St
(Thurs 5 May & Fri 6 May)

St Helens:

St Helens (Portland) Memorial Hall, Cecilia St
(Thurs 5 May & Fri 6 May)

Triabunna:

Triabunna Council Chambers (Old) Recreation Room, 38 Vicary St,
(Thurs 5 May & Fri 6 May)

Alternatively, postal vote applications are available at any post office within the Apsley and Elwick divisions, at any Tasmanian electoral office, on our website www.tec.tas.gov.au or by calling 1800 801 701.

Electors who are interstate can vote at any Australian Electoral Commission divisional office, or other state or territory Electoral Commissions (from Wednesday 20 April).

Electors who will be overseas or in a remote area outside Tasmania during the polling period may apply for an express vote at www.tec.tas.gov.au.

Assistance for vision-impaired electors

An electronic system to assist vision-impaired electors to vote independently will be available during the pre-poll period and on polling day. For more details electors can call 1800 801 701.
