

MEDIA RELEASE — 2014 LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Update on the count

Parliamentary elections were held today, Saturday 3 May, for the Legislative Council divisions of Huon and Rosevears.

Final polling night figures are shown on the following 2 pages. All figures are provisional and will be rechecked tomorrow morning (Sunday 4 May). In the following commentary, percentages relate to the total formal votes counted so far.

In **Huon**, Peter Hodgman (26.08%) leads Robert Armstrong (20.47%), Liz Smith (19.10%) and Jimmy Bell (15.50%). The result will depend on the inclusion of outstanding votes and the distribution of preferences.

In **Rosevears**, Kerry Finch (60.26%) leads Don Morris (39.74%) and Mr Finch has been returned as the Member.
