



ABORIGINAL LAND COUNCIL OF TASMANIA

SOUTH REGION BY-ELECTION

In accordance with the *Aboriginal Lands Act 1995*, a by-election, conducted by postal ballot, will be held to fill a vacancy for one South region representative on the Aboriginal Land Council of Tasmania (ALCT).

This vacancy was created by the resignation of Aaron Everett. The term of the position will be for the remainder of Mr Everett's three year term.

NOMINATIONS INVITED

Nominations are invited for election to fill the vacant position on the Council.

To nominate as a representative for the South region, a person must be enrolled on the ALCT Electors Roll for an address in that region. Every person who is entitled to vote will be sent by post this notice and a nomination form.

Nominations must be lodged, posted, emailed or faxed so as to be received by the Electoral Commissioner at the Tasmanian Electoral Commission, before 12 noon on Friday 23 June 2017.

As part of the nomination form candidates are invited to provide a statement of up to 150 words to accompany the ballot papers sent to electors.
