I have the honour to submit the following report upon elections conducted during the period 1980 to 1982.

THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

Appendix A of this report shows enrolment figures for all Legislative Council Divisions as at 30 June 1982.

The total enrolment shown in the preceding report was 250 681 on 30 June 1979. Since that time the total has increased by 13 479 to 264 160, which is equivalent to 92.41 per cent of electors enrolled for the House of Assembly elections (285 870).

During the period under review, 93 337 additions were made to the rolls; there were 79 858 deletions and 22 174 alterations to obtain the net increase of 13 479.

Appendix B contains details of the Legislative Council Re-Division which became effective on the day after the day fixed for holding the first periodical election of Members after the passing of the Constitution Amendment Act No. 78 of 1980. During June and July 1981, 31 832 names were transferred on the various rolls and each elector was advised of that change of enrolment.

THE GORDON RIVER HYDRO-ELECTRIC POWER DEVELOPMENT REFERENDUM

The results of the above referendum are detailed in Appendix E of this report.

A Writ was issued on the seventeenth day of November 1981 by His Excellency the Governor couched in the following terms:—

‘Both Houses of the Tasmanian Parliament favour the construction of a new hydro-electric power scheme on the Gordon River in south-western Tasmania and considers it desirable that a referendum should be held to advise the Parliament as to which of 2 possible locations on that river should be used for the construction of such a scheme. Accordingly, we command that you cause to be submitted, according to law, to the electors qualified to vote for the election of members to the House of Assembly, a question to determine whether the electors prefer that such a scheme be located on the Gordon River above its junction with the Olga River or on the Gordon River below its junction with the Franklin River.’

The referendum was held on 12 December 1981. During the scrutiny, the admission to the count of some 23 839 votes was challenged by the Tasmanian Wilderness Society through their legal representatives, Messrs Murdoch, Clarke, Cosgrove and Drake. The argument advanced by them was that the marking on those ballot papers was not in accordance with the precise wording of the Act authorising the referendum. In their view any subjective acceptance of the intent by the electors at the referendum was not permitted and if indeed it was, Court proceedings would be contemplated. Crown Law advice at the time, supported the argument advanced by the Tasmanian Wilderness Society and some 23 839 votes were accordingly removed from the count and rejected as informal. Subsequently the Solicitor-General and the Chief Parliamentary Counsel both disagreed with the earlier Crown Law opinion, and produced substantive argument supporting the acceptance of those votes previously rejected. The published results and as shown on the returned Writ are in accordance with the earlier legal advice. Many of the votes rejected were marked in accordance with Commonwealth Law in that choices were indicated by the use of the affirmative and the negative establishing no doubt as to the clear intent of those electors. The subsequent legal advice was also to the effect that it was not proposed to correct the results shown on the returned Writ and as published in the Gazette; this decision was taken since the results of the Referendum were not contemplated as consequential and no particular action was contingent upon the results.

The result tables published in this report show both sets of statistics, taking into account the consequences of the rejection and the inclusion of the 23 839 votes in dispute.

THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY

The Assembly was dissolved by proclamation issued by His Excellency the Governor on 27 March 1982.

The following dates were fixed for the purposes of the General Election:—

Issue of Writs — 5 April 1982;

Nominations — 16 April 1982;

Poll — 15 May 1982;

Return of Writs — On or Before 25 May 1982.

The Writs were returned on 25 May 1982 from which date the life of Parliament commenced.

Nominations for this election totalled 127 (Bass, 24; Braddon, 24; Denison, 30; Franklin, 26; Wilmot, 23).

The draw for party group position on the ballot paper resulted in the Liberal Group being placed first in two Divisions, the Australian Democrats first in two Divisions and an Independent Group first in the remaining Division.

The electors were provided with 399 polling booths at which 236 943 ordinary votes, 19 644 absent votes and 760 votes under sections 116A and 111 were recorded.

Returning Officers and Registrars have performed their duties, often at short notice, with efficiency and consideration. Despite the substantial problem of a state print of the new format of ballot paper, the Government Printer's office completed the undertaking, together with all the other printing requirements of the House of Assembly election on 15 May and the Legislative Council on 22 May, to the complete satisfaction of this Department. Thanks is also due to Officers of the Police Department who materially assisted at the time of the Referendum and who patrol polling booths at all Elections.

The Census of 1981 showed the proportion of adults to be 664 per 1 000 of the total population of Tasmania.

The proportion of informal votes (5.66 per cent) represents an increase of 1.81 per cent on 1979. The divisions showed percentages ranging from 5.04 in Braddon to 5.98 in Franklin.

The number of candidates totalled a record 127, the total number of counts was 2 091 and the greatest number of counts in a division occurred in Denison where 519 were recorded.

The preceding table, giving the percentage of electors who exercised the franchise at all general elections, both State and Federal, since 1916, indicates roughly the rise and fall of political interest among the electors up to 1928. Both its rise and fall are much more pronounced in the case of women than of men. The proportions for the subsequent elections are dominated by compulsory voting, first in the Federal sphere and later in the State. The absence of many electors from the State on military service would largely account for the lower percentages of voters at the elections in 1940 and 1941.

REPRESENTATION OF PARTIES

At the election of 15 May 1982, 127 candidates were nominated. Of these, 35 were endorsed nominees of the Liberal Party, 38 were nominated by the Labor Party, 22 were nominated by the Australian Democrat Party and 32 nominated as Independents (both Grouped and Ungrouped).

The result was the return of 19 Liberal, 14 Labor, 1 Australian Democrat and 1 Independent.

The No. 1 votes were cast directly for the four groups in each of the five electoral divisions of the State as follows:—

The method of election is briefly the 'single transferable vote' system, and the law provides that a seat be allotted to each complete quota of votes in each division.

The quota in each division is ascertained by the following formula:—

$$\frac{\text{Number of valid ballot-papers}}{\text{Number to be elected} + 1} + 1 = \text{Quota}$$

Any remainder is ignored.

The following table shows for each division, and for the State as a whole, the number of first preference votes, the number of quotas, and the seats won by each party:—

The preferential system of voting therefore resulted in over-representation of 2.02 Liberal and 1.10 Labor at the expense of other candidates according to the State-wide First Choice Support.

ABSENT VOTES, POSTAL VOTES, AND SECTION VOTES

Under the provisions of section 116A, 760 persons whose names were not on the roll claimed the right to vote, and filled in ballot-papers. Of these 575 were rejected because their claim to be on the roll could not be sustained. The remaining 185 were admitted to the scrutiny and 10 of them rejected for informalities, leaving 175 valid votes under section 116A.

The number of absent votes was 19 644 but these included some whose names were not, in fact, on the roll, and 1 505 were rejected on this account. A further 955 were rejected for informalities leaving 17 184 valid absent votes.

Taking together the section claims and attempts to vote under provisions for electors absent from their usual subdivisions, the number of votes disallowed were: 1982, 2 180; 1979, 2 736; 1976, 1 921; 1972, 2 185; 1969, 1 505; 1964, 2 537; 1959, 2 515; 1956, 1 941; 1955, 1 703; 1950, 1 749; 1948, 1 650; 1946, 1 448; 1941, 2 283; 1937, 1 897; 1934, 1 687; 1931, 2 086. These disallowed votes are not counted either as votes recorded or as informal votes.

INFORMAL BALLOT PAPERS
