I have the honour to submit the following report upon elections conducted during the period 1987 to 1989.

THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

Appendix A of this report shows enrolment figures for all Legislative Council Divisions as at 30 June 1989.

The total enrolment shown in the preceding report was 270, 220 on 30 June 1986. Since that time the total has increased by 15 558 to 285 778 which is equivalent to 91.01 per cent of electors enrolled on the joint Commonwealth and House of Assembly electoral roll (313 994).

During the period under review 79 806 additions were made to the rolls; there were 64 248 deletions and 21 190 alterations to obtain the net increase of 15 558.

THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY

The Assembly was dissolved by a proclamation issued by His Excellency the Governor on 18 April 1989.

The following dates were fixed for the purposes of the General Election:—

Issue of Writs—19 April 1989

Nominations—27 April 1989

Poll—13 May 1989

Return of Writs—On or before 9 June 1989.

The writs were returned on 29 May 1989, from which date the life of Parliament commenced.

Nominations for this election totalled 103 (Bass 20, Braddon 21, Denison 22, Franklin 21, Lyons 19).

The draw for party group position on the ballot-paper resulted in the Liberal Group being placed first in two Divisions, the Labor Group first in two Divisions and the Australian Democrats first in the remaining Division.

The electors were provided with 337 polling-booths at which 262 296 ordinary votes, 15 041 absent votes and 2 345 votes under sections 127 and 128 were recorded.

LEGISLATION

During the period covered by this report the *Electoral Act 1985* was amended by Act No. 23 of 1989.

This amendment provided for the receipt of postal votes up to ten days after polling-day providing they had been posted prior to the close of the poll. Previously such votes were required to be returned to the Returning Officer by the close of polling.

The amendment also provided for the use of seals other than padlocks on ballot-boxes and was necessary to accommodate the use of cardboard ballot-boxes. For many years the State which owns no ballot-boxes or voting screens had sought and obtained the use of these items from the Commonwealth. Because of high storage costs, greater ease of handling and less likelihood of injury to persons transporting these items, the Commonwealth disposed of the majority of its stocks and moved to the use of cardboard polling-booth equipment. As a consequence, and despite increased costs, it was necessary for the State to also use cardboard voting screens and ballot-boxes.

Whilst small quantities of the metal ballot-boxes and wooden and polypropylene screens were purchased by some municipal councils from the Commonwealth, the vast majority of that equipment which was otherwise purchased by such persons as scrap metal dealers were disposed of and is no longer available. It will be possible for some Legislative Council elections therefore to use those items purchased by municipal councils. However, for the majority of Legislative Council elections and all House of Assembly elections, cardboard equipment will be necessary.

FORMAT OF ELECTION REPORT

The following alterations have been made to the format of this report.

1. Additional Statistical Tables

- Tables of primary votes received by candidates at each polling-place have been included for both House of Assembly and Legislative Council elections held from 1989. Previously these details were only provided in respect of House of Assembly elections and then only on the basis of subdivisional results;
- A statistical analysis of informal voting within each of five divisions at the 1989 House of Assembly Election is included in Table 2 of Appendix D.

2. Statistical Tables No Longer Included

The following tables have been deleted from the report:—

- (a) Percentage of Electors Voting at Federal and State House of Assembly Elections Since 1916;
- (b) Representation of Parties for Assembly Elections Since 1931;
- (c) Absent, Postal and Section Voting Since 1959;
- (d) Percentage of Informal Ballot-papers Since 1912;
- (e) Details of Dates of Federal and State House of Assembly Elections and Referendums Since 1912.

These tables simply repeated in each report the same historical data, up-dated to the last elections included in the report. For persons wishing to maintain such statistics, they are readily available from other tables in this report for inclusion in the tables printed in the previous report.

3. Expanded Tables

Table 9 of the previous report, which contained details of section and absent voting by division has been expanded in Table 8 of this report, to include details of institution, pre-poll and postal voting.

Table 10 of the previous report which contained details by division of valid postal, pre-poll and institution votes received by parties, has been expanded in Table 9 of this report to include details of section and absent votes.

4. Lay-out of Tables Showing Distribution of Preferences

These tables in respect to elections and by-elections for both the House of Assembly and Legislative Council have been re-designed so that the counts of the scrutiny and the progressive results are displayed left to right on the page rather than horizontally. The presentation of these statistics in this way provides a more readable format and facilitates ease of analysis and extraction of information from the tables.

REPRESENTATION OF PARTIES OR GROUPS

At the election of 13 May 1989 103 candidates were nominated. Of these thirty-five were endorsed nominees of the Liberal Party, thirty-six were nominated by the Labor Party, ten were nominated by the Australian Democrat Party, sixteen nominated as Grouped Independents and six as Ungrouped Independents.

The result was the return of seventeen Liberal, thirteen Labor and five Grouped Independents.

The method of election is briefly the 'single transferable vote' system, and the law provides that a seat be allotted to each complete quota of votes in each division.

The quota in each division is ascertained by the following formula:—

$$\frac{\text{Number of valid ballot-papers}}{\text{Number to be elected}} + 1 = \text{Quota}$$

Any remainder is ignored.

The following table shows for each division, and for the State as a whole, the number of first preference votes, the number of quotas and the seats won by each party:—
